

Congratulations on your cmd_key!

The **cmd_key** for QLab keyboard is pre-programmed from the factory to work with QLab 4 from Figure 53. It is programmed using the default keyboard shortcuts provided with QLab 4.

You can assign Hot Keys 1-5 and A-F for cue triggers or scripting of your choice. Please refer the the QLab manual on how to assign them.

When you plug the keyboard into the Mac for the first time, MacOS might ask you to identify the keyboard by pressing a specific key on the keyboard. Just close that window and your Mac will treat it as a QWERTY keyboard, which is how it's programmed.

cmd_key is programmed for QWERTY US Layout only.

The hub underneath the **cmd_key** can be used for a Mouse. It is not designed for a USB Thumb Drive. It is underpowered for that type of device.
